Study Structure at KISD

In the study course »Integrated Studies in Design«, you will work in multi-semester projects and seminars on complex design processes and acquire a broad knowledge of contents, working practices, and methodologies of design while developing extensive analytical, conceptual and design specific competence, which is linked with cross-cultural and international experience.

KISD studies are project-oriented and support a multi-semester collaboration, thus enabling students to learn with and from one another. In addition to the projects, seminars, lectures, courses, working groups, workshop introductions and a mentoring program round off the study framework. Therefore, the study framework is only partly linear. Every semester students can choose from a wide range of courses.

All students at KISD get credit points (ECTS) for their courses. The European Credit Transfer Accumulation System (ECTS) is based on the principle that 30 credits measure the workload of one semester. The workload of a full-time study program in Europe adds up to around 900 hours per semester and in those cases one credit correlates to about 30 working hours. For international exchange students it varies and depends on the specification of the home university. Please figure out how many credit points you have to achieve during your semester abroad. Through these symbols you can see how much credits you can get for each course category.

Projects 3 CP 6 CP 12 CP

The most important part of your studies here at KISD is represented by the projects you choose. Each project is offered only for one semster by one of our professors. In all courses at KISD you work with students from different semesters. Almost every Friday there are public presentations where students present their project results. There are three types of projects: Short-term, Mid-term and Long-term projects. Depending on the length of the projects you will receive 3, 6 or 12 credit points (ECTS) each.

Choose 12 CP for projects (e.g. two medium-term projects, or two short-term projects plus one midterm project).

Scientific and Technical Seminars 4CP 3CP

Scientific Seminars are a reflexive component and form an indispensable unit in order to combine practical design-oriented projects together with these seminars. Supporting documents for a successful participation are reports as well as extensive documentations or investigations in written or in a medial form.

Technical Seminars provide complex or detailed basics and perspectives from the respective technical work area and are offered by technical lecturers and staff from science and research.

Choose 4 CP for a scientific seminar and optional 3 CP for a technical seminar.

Courses 1 CP 2 CP

By taking *courses* at KISD you might improve your technical skills. Please be aware that the courses are just an additional offer and not the backbone of your studies at KISD. You will receive 1 or 2 credit points (ECTS) for each.

Mentoring 4

All KISD students take part in a *mentoring program*. You have several group meetings during the semester with your supervisors. Part of your mentoring program is to reflect about your individual studies at KISD as well as the weekly KISDtalks, lectures and the Friday presentations.

In these courses you become a member of the KISD community structuring and organising important daily internal procedures. For participating in one of those work groups, you will receive 2 credit points (ECTS).

The first project at KISD for all our new students, supervised by all professors. Here you will get to know KISD and your fellow students, and for the first time you will present yourself to KISD. This project is mandatory for all new students.

The KISDessentials are an ambitious approach to better understand the KISD workshops. You will be divided into several groups and gain experience at various places in the KISD (for example: Wood Workshop, Photo Studio, Computer Lab, Textile Lab, Virtual Reality Lab, ...).

Proofs of Performance

As proof of performance you get a document called Trancript of Records. Please make a documentation about the project (together with your fellow students), write a course report and collect the signatures of your lecturers when the course is over. Usually we do not have grades for courses. If your home university requires a grade for a class, please ask the lecturer for a German grade. In the end of the semester you are asked to write a semester report.

TH Köln campusID

During enrollment you will receive your personal university account from the TH Köln by mail. That is your *campusID*. It consists of a login name and a password. At the campusID-Center you can change your password and set up forwarding of your university emails to your private email address.

The campusID will permit you to use many university services, such as

- access to the Internet via the TH Köln WLAN
- Internet access via APs of other German universities (eduroam)
- access to the intranet of the TH Köln
- access to the university network via VPN
- semester ticket NRW print service

- choose a login name with a maximum of 8 characters and a password
- open your account by using this login name and your temporary password. Your KISD email address has the following format: login-name@kisd.de (and:first-name.lastname@kisd.de)
- immediately set up email forwarding to your private email address or the email address of the TH Köln (KISDspaces > Profile > Click to edit your profile)
- upload a photo of yourself for the account(KISDspaces > Profile > Click to edit your profile)
